"AN ACT CONCERNING ACCOUNTABILITY IN CONTRACTING WITH STATE AGENCIES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (c) of section 4-70b of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
5 *1, 2007*):

6 (c) The secretary shall establish uniform policies and procedures for
7 obtaining, managing and evaluating the quality and cost effectiveness
8 of human services purchased from private providers. The secretary
9 shall ensure all state agencies which purchase human services comply
10 with such policies and procedures. The secretary may waive the
11 competitive procurement requirements set forth in chapter 55a with
12 respect to any contract between a state agency and a private provider
13 of human services. The secretary shall report to the General Assembly
14 on or before January 1, 1994, and biennially thereafter, on the system

15 for the purchase of such services in the state. The report shall include
16 an analysis of (1) the relationship between the number of providers of
17 a particular service in a region and the cost of the service, and (2) the
18 impact of the state's policies and procedures for the purchase of
19 human services on the cost of purchasing such services."
