"AN ACT CONCERNING THE DISCLOSURE OF SENSITIVE RECORDS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 1-217 of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

5 (a) No public agency may disclose, under the Freedom of
6 Information Act, the residential address of any of the following
7 persons:

8 (1) A federal court judge, federal court magistrate, judge of the
9 Superior Court, Appellate Court or Supreme Court of the state, or
10 family support magistrate;

11 (2) A sworn member of a municipal police department, [or] a sworn
12 member of the Division of State Police within the Department of Public
13 Safety or a conservation enforcement officer or special conservation

14 officer appointed by the Commissioner of Environmental Protection
15 pursuant to section 26-5;

16 (3) An employee of the Department of Correction;

17 (4) An attorney-at-law who represents or has represented the state
18 in a criminal prosecution;

19 (5) An attorney-at-law who is or has been employed by the Public
20 Defender Services Division or a social worker who is employed by the
21 Public Defender Services Division;

22 (6) An inspector employed by the Division of Criminal Justice;

23 (7) A firefighter;

24 (8) An employee of the Department of Children and Families;

25 (9) A member or employee of the Board of Pardons and Paroles;

26 (10) An employee of the judicial branch; or

27 (11) A member or employee of the Commission on Human Rights
28 and Opportunities.

29 (b) The business address of any person described in this section
30 shall be subject to disclosure under section 1-210. The provisions of this
31 section shall not apply to Department of Motor Vehicles records
32 described in section 14-10."
