**"AN ACT CONCERNING ELECTION DAY REGISTRATION,
CHANGES TO THE CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS, AND CERTAIN
COMPENSATION OF REGISTRARS OF VOTERS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 9-20 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
5 *passage*):

6 (a) Each person who applies for admission as an elector in person to
7 an admitting official shall, upon a form prescribed by the Secretary of
8 the State and signed by the applicant, state under penalties of perjury,
9 his name, bona fide residence by street and number, date of birth,
10 whether he is a United States citizen, whether his privileges as an
11 elector are forfeited by reason of conviction of crime, and whether he
12 has previously been admitted as an elector in any town in this or any
13 other state. Each such applicant shall present [his] a valid photo
14 identification card, as determined by the registrar of voters and either

15 a birth certificate, drivers' license or Social Security card to the
16 admitting official for inspection at the time of application.
17 Notwithstanding the provisions of any special act or charter to the
18 contrary, the application form shall also, in a manner prescribed by the
19 Secretary of the State, provide for application for enrollment in any
20 political party, including, on any such form printed on or after January
21 1, 2006, a list of the names of the major parties, as defined in section 9-
22 372, as options for the applicant. The form shall indicate that such
23 enrollment is not mandatory."
