**"AN ACT CONCERNING GLOBAL WARMING AND BROWNFIELDS
REMEDICATION AND DEVELOPMENT."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2007*) (a) No person shall cause
4 or allow a motor vehicle to operate for more than three consecutive
5 minutes when such motor vehicle is not in motion, except as follows:

6 (1) When a motor vehicle is forced to remain motionless because of
7 traffic conditions or mechanical difficulties over which the operator
8 has no control;

9 (2) When it is necessary to operate defrosting, heating or cooling
10 equipment to ensure the safety or health of the driver or passengers;

11 (3) When it is necessary to operate auxiliary equipment that is
12 located in or on the motor vehicle to accomplish the intended use of
13 the motor vehicle;

14 (4) When it is necessary to bring the motor vehicle to the
15 manufacturer's recommended operating temperature;

16 (5) When the outdoor temperature is below twenty degrees
17 Fahrenheit;

18 (6) When the motor vehicle is undergoing maintenance or an
19 inspection that requires such motor vehicle be operated for more than
20 three consecutive minutes;

21 (7) When a motor vehicle is in queue to be inspected by United
22 States military personnel prior to gaining access to a United States
23 military installation;

24 (8) When a law enforcement, firefighting rescue or emergency
25 vehicle is in the course of responding to an emergency; or

26 (9) When a motor vehicle is in a queue at a drive-in establishment.

27 For the purposes of this section, "motor vehicle" means any automobile
28 or truck.

29 (b) A violation of any provision of this section shall be an
30 infraction."
