"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PALLIATIVE USE OF MARIJUANA."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2007*) The Department of Public Safety
4 shall study the impact of the legalization of palliative marijuana use in
5 the states of Alaska, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Maine, Montana,
6 Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon, Vermont and Washington, and shall
7 analyze: (1) The impact on the local and state police departments of
8 those states of the enforcement of fraudulent claims associated with
9 such legalization; and (2) the overall increase of arrests for the illegal
10 use of marijuana in those states. On or before February 1, 2008, the
11 department shall report its findings and recommendations to the joint
12 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
13 matters relating to public safety, in accordance with the provisions of
14 section 11-4a of the general statutes."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>July 1, 2007</i>	New section
