**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE FACULTY AT PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS
OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND REVISIONS TO VARIOUS HIGHER
EDUCATION STATUTES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (c) of section 10a-22b of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
5 *October 1, 2007*):

6 (c) Each person, board, association, partnership, corporation, limited
7 liability company or other entity which seeks to offer occupational
8 instruction shall submit to the commissioner, or the commissioner's
9 designee, in such manner as the commissioner, or the commissioner's
10 designee, shall prescribe, an application for a certificate of
11 authorization which includes, but need not be limited to, (1) the
12 proposed name of the school; (2) ownership and organization of the
13 school including the names and addresses of all principals, officers,

14 members and directors; (3) names and addresses of all stockholders of
15 the school, except for applicants which are listed on a national
16 securities exchange; (4) addresses of any building or premises on
17 which the school will be located; (5) description of the occupational
18 instruction to be offered; (6) the proposed student enrollment
19 agreement, which includes for each program of occupational
20 instruction offered a description, in plain language, of any
21 requirements for employment in such occupation or barriers to such
22 employment pursuant to state law or regulations; (7) the proposed
23 school catalog, which includes for each program of occupational
24 instruction offered a description, in plain language, of any
25 requirements for employment in such occupation or barriers to such
26 employment pursuant to state law or regulations; (8) financial
27 statements detailing the financial condition of the school prepared by
28 management and reviewed or audited by an independent licensed
29 certified public accountant or independent licensed public accountant;
30 and (9) an agent for service of process. Submitted with an application
31 for initial authorization shall be a nonrefundable application fee in the
32 amount of two thousand dollars made payable to the private
33 occupational school student protection account."
