**"AN ACT CONCERNING UNIVERSITY BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR PERMITS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (f) of section 30-16 of the general statutes is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*  
5 *passage*):

6 (f) A manufacturer permit for a brew pub shall allow: [the] (1) The  
7 manufacture, storage and bottling of beer, (2) the retail sale of alcoholic  
8 liquor to be consumed on the premises with or without the sale of  
9 food, [and] (3) the selling at retail from the premises of sealed bottles  
10 or other sealed containers of beer brewed on such premises for  
11 consumption off the premises, and (4) the sale of sealed bottles or other  
12 sealed containers of beer brewed on such premises to the holder of a

13 wholesaler permit issued pursuant to section 30-17, provided that the  
14 holder of a manufacturer permit for a brew pub produces at least five  
15 thousand gallons of beer on the premises annually. Such selling at  
16 retail from the premises of sealed bottles or other sealed containers  
17 shall comply with the provisions of subsection (d) of section 30-91 and  
18 shall permit not more than eight liters of beer to be sold to any person  
19 on any day on which such sale is authorized under the provisions of  
20 subsection (d) of section 30-91. The annual fee for a manufacturer  
21 permit for a brew pub shall be two hundred forty dollars."
