"AN ACT LIMITING LAW ENFORCEMENT ACCESS TO RECORDED INFORMATION IN "BLACK BOX" EVENT DATA RECORDERS IN MOTOR VEHICLES."

1 Strike subsection (a) of section 1 in its entirety and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(a) As used in this section: (1) "Event data recorder" means a device
4 installed in a passenger motor vehicle, as defined in section 14-1 of the
5 general statutes, that (A) records (i) transaxle speed, (ii) the direction in
6 which the motor vehicle is traveling, (iii) steering performance data,
7 (iv) brake performance data, including, but not limited to, whether the
8 brakes were applied before an accident, (v) the usage of the operator's
9 seat belt, (vi) engine speed, or (vii) throttle position, or (B) is capable of
10 transmitting data concerning an accident in which the motor vehicle is

11 involved to a central communications system; and (2) "lessee" means
12 an individual who leases or rents a passenger motor vehicle for such
13 individual's personal use pursuant to a written agreement for a term of
14 more than one year."
