1 In line 25, bracket "The" and after the closing bracket insert "When
2 necessary to protect the health or safety of a student or other
3 individual, the"

4 Strike lines 32 and 33, in their entirety and insert the following in
5 lieu thereof:

6 "sponsored activity or on a school bus, which acts are [repeated
7 against the same student over time] committed more than once against
8 any student during the school year. Such policies may include"

9 In line 37, strike "If" and insert "On and after January 1, 2008, if"

10 Strike lines 40 to 42, inclusive, in their entirety, and insert the
11 following in lieu thereof:

12 "withhold an amount not less than two thousand five hundred
13 dollars or more than ten thousand dollars from a grant payment as

14 determined by the Commissioner of Education during the fiscal year
15 following the fiscal year in which noncompliance is determined
16 pursuant to this subsection. The commissioner shall give the local or
17 regional board of education an opportunity to explain its actions
18 before withholding funds."

19 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
20 internal references accordingly:

21 "Sec. 501. Subdivision (3) subsection (a) of section 10-233d of the
22 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
23 thereof (*Effective July 1, 2007*):

24 (3) Unless an emergency exists, no pupil shall be expelled without a
25 formal hearing held pursuant to sections 4-176e to 4-180a, inclusive,
26 and section 4-181a, provided whenever such pupil is a minor, the
27 notice required by section 4-177 and section 4-180 shall also be given to
28 the parents or guardian of the pupil. If an emergency exists, such
29 hearing shall be held as soon after the expulsion as possible. The notice
30 shall include information concerning legal services provided free of
31 charge or at a reduced rate that are available locally and how to access
32 such services."
