**"AN ACT UPDATING THE SOCIAL SECURITY RETIREMENT AGE
TO REFLECT FEDERAL CHANGES."**

- 1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:
- 3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) (a) Any member of the state
4 employees retirement system who is serving as a judicial marshal on
5 the effective date of this section and who served as a special deputy
6 sheriff on or after July 1, 1990, or who is a state employee who served
7 as a special deputy sheriff on or after July 1, 1990, and has been in
8 continuous state service since July 1, 1990, may elect to purchase
9 retirement credit for such prior special deputy sheriff service rendered
10 on or after July 1, 1990, provided such member provides written

11 notification of such election to the State Employees Retirement
12 Commission on or before October 1, 2007, and makes retirement
13 contributions for such prior service in an amount equal to the
14 contributions that would have been required to be made by the
15 member in accordance with the terms of the retirement plan to which
16 the member belongs on or after the effective date of this section.

17 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) of this section,
18 the total annual cost to the state employees retirement system for the
19 payment of retirement benefits attributable to the additional retirement
20 credit purchased under said subsection shall not exceed eight hundred
21 fifty thousand dollars. On or before March 1, 2008, after eligible
22 members have notified the State Employees Retirement Commission of
23 the election to purchase such additional retirement credit, the State
24 Employees Retirement Commission shall certify to the exclusive
25 bargaining agents for the judicial marshals the total annual cost to the
26 state employees retirement system for the payment of retirement
27 benefits attributable to the additional retirement credit purchased. If
28 such total annual cost exceeds eight hundred fifty thousand dollars,
29 the exclusive bargaining agents for the judicial marshals shall
30 determine the amount of retirement credit each eligible judicial
31 marshal may purchase so as not to exceed, in total, eight hundred fifty
32 thousand dollars."
