"AN ACT LIMITING LAW ENFORCEMENT ACCESS TO RECORDED INFORMATION IN "BLACK BOX" EVENT DATA RECORDERS IN MOTOR VEHICLES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (d) of section 14-296aa of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
5 *1, 2007*):

6 (d) No person under eighteen years of age shall use any hand-held
7 mobile telephone, including one with a hands-free accessory, or a
8 mobile electronic device while operating a moving motor vehicle on a
9 public highway, except as provided in subparagraph (A) of
10 subdivision (4) of subsection (b) of this section. No person under
11 eighteen years of age shall be permitted to purchase a disposable
12 hand-held mobile telephone."
