**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A  
CONNECTICUT MILK COMMISSION."**

1      Strike section 1 in its entirety, and renumber the remaining sections  
2      and internal references accordingly

3      Strike lines 108 to 116, inclusive, in their entirety, and renumber  
4      internal references accordingly

5      Strike sections 3 to 13, inclusive, in their entirety, and renumber  
6      remaining sections and internal references accordingly

7      After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
8      internal references accordingly:

9      "Sec. 501. (*Effective July 1, 2007*) The Connecticut Milk Commission  
10     established under section 2 of this act shall, in consultation with the  
11     Commissioners of Environmental Protection and Agriculture and milk  
12     producers in the state of Connecticut, study the feasibility of  
13     developing a state-wide system for the recycling of cardboard and

14 cardboard composite milk and milk drink containers. Such study shall  
15 include, but not be limited to, the development of a public education  
16 and outreach program and estimate any solid waste collection and  
17 processing changes that are necessary to create such state-wide system.  
18 On or before January 1, 2008, the Connecticut Milk Commission shall  
19 submit a report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of  
20 the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General  
21 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the environment.  
22 Such report shall contain the Connecticut Milk Commission's findings  
23 regarding such study and recommendations regarding the  
24 establishment of a program to assure the collection and recycling of  
25 cardboard milk containers in the state."
