**"AN ACT CONCERNING ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, AUDITING OF LARGE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS, ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW OF CERTAIN LAND TRANSFERS, GRANT PAYMENTS TO MUNICIPALITIES, ADVERTISING ON STATE BUILDINGS AND CERTAIN EXEMPTIONS TO THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT."**

1      After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2      internal references accordingly:

3      "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding any  
4      provision of the general statutes, if the Commissioner of Public Works  
5      requires any person submitting a bid related to the construction,  
6      reconstruction, alteration, remodeling, repair or demolition of any  
7      public building for work by the state having a cost to the state of five  
8      million dollars or more to obtain a cost analysis of such project, such  
9      cost analysis shall be prepared by a certified professional estimator  
10     certified by the American Society of Professional Estimators or such  
11     other professional organization recognized by the commissioner."
