Substitute House Bill No. 5593

*House of Representatives, April 7, 2008*

The Committee on Education reported through REP. FLEISCHMANN of the 18th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

***AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF ISSUES CONCERNING THE INTERDISTRICT MAGNET SCHOOL GRANT PROGRAM.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Education shall  
2 study issues concerning the interdistrict magnet school grant program  
3 under section 10-264l of the 2008 supplement to the general statutes.  
4 Not later than January 3, 2009, the Commissioner of Education shall  
5 report on such study to the joint standing committee of the General  
6 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to education in  
7 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
