Explanation

The resolution accepts the Claims Commissioner's recommendation to dismiss this claim. The resolution thereby avoids a potential significant state cost for any judgments that might be rendered against it, since the claimant is seeking recovery of \$7.5 million in damages. It also precludes a workload increase for the Office of the Attorney General and potential litigation expenses incurred by the Department of Social Services and the Office of the Chief State's Attorney.
