RESOLUTION PROPOSING APPROVAL OF A STIPULATED AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT AND THE ADMINISTRATIVE RESIDUAL EMPLOYEES UNION, P-5 BARGAINING UNIT.

Resolved by this House:

- 1 That the stipulated agreement between the State of Connecticut and
- 2 the Administrative Residual Employees Union, P-5 Bargaining Unit,
- 3 concerning certain purchasing and collection job classifications, filed
- 4 on April 23, 2008, and submitted to this assembly for approval, as
- 5 provided in subsection (b) of section 5-278 of the general statutes, is
- 6 approved.

Explanation

This stipulated agreement for the Administrative and Residual Employees' (P-5) bargaining unit is submitted for approval. The agreement provides lump sum bonuses to certain employees who held Purchasing or Collection Services titles. Seven bargaining unit members who held such titles as of June 30, 2004, and moved into other P-5 classes prior to October 12, 2007, will each receive a \$1,000 lump sum bonus. Six bargaining unit members who held such titles as of June 30, 2003, and retired from state service prior to October 12, 2007, will each receive a \$2,000 lump sum bonus.

The FY 08 General Fund cost of this agreement is \$19,000, plus an additional \$1,454 for associated Social Security costs, totaling \$20,454. Funding is available in Reserve for Salary Adjustments account to cover the cost of this agreement.
