The Committee on Higher Education and Employment Advancement reported through SEN. HARTLEY of the 15th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF HIGHER EDUCATION ISSUES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Higher
2 Education shall study trends in higher education. Not later than
3 January 3, 2009, the Commissioner of Higher Education shall report on
4 such study to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
5 having cognizance of matters relating to higher education in
6 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
