**Affordable health coverage to uninsured adults is desperately needed here in Connecticut. My husband, who is a self employed carpenter, and myself have been covered under the Husky program because of our children. In several months our youngest child will be too old to be covered by Husky. When this time comes, we will be a family of six without health coverage. Our four children will be college students who cannot afford health insurance. My husband and I also will be unable to afford health insurance. The Charter Oak Plan is an answer to our prayers and to delay the start up of this program, would be devastating; not only to our family, but to many other Connecticut workers. I urge you not to delay the implementation of the Charter Oak plan. We need an affordable health insurance plan now – not in 2009 or 2010. This is something that cannot be postponed and to cause it to be delayed in unacceptable. I urge you to continue taking steps to insure the Charter Oak Health Plan becomes available to Connecticut residents in July 2008.**
