AN ACT CONCERNING AN APPROPRIATION FOR COMMUNITY-BASED EMPLOYMENT AND EDUCATIONAL PILOT PROGRAMS FOR YOUTH IN THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of one million five hundred thousand dollars be
- 2 appropriated to the Judicial Department, from the General Fund, for
- 3 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, for the purpose of providing funds
- 4 to establish community-based pilot programs in Hartford, Bridgeport
- 5 and New Haven to provide employment and educational "step-down"
- 6 services for youth in the criminal justice system.

Statement of Purpose:

To help youth in the criminal justice system by offering life-skill training and assessment of family needs in order to provide a smoother transition back into their communities.
