AN ACT INCREASING FUNDING FOR THE SMALL TOWN ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 4-66g of the 2008 supplement to the general statutes be
- 2 amended to increase funding to not less than thirty million dollars per
- 3 year.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand the Small Town Economic Assistance Program (STEAP) to a minimum of thirty million dollars per year, to meet the ongoing economic development needs of the 139 suburban and rural towns that are eligible for the program.
