**AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS OF THE STATE TO THE
AGRICULTURAL EXPERIMENT STATION FOR TESTING REGARDING
THE HEALTH EFFECTS OF GROUND UP RUBBER TIRES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of two hundred thousand dollars be appropriated to
- 2 the Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station, from the General
- 3 Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, for testing regarding the
- 4 health effects of ground up rubber tires used in playing fields.
