**AN ACT CONCERNING AN OPEN SPACE GRANT FOR THE
MAROMAS PARCEL IN MIDDLETOWN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the Department of Environmental Protection shall make an
2 open space grant in accordance with section 7-131d of the general
3 statutes to the city of Middletown for the purchase of the forty-acre
4 meadow and forest parcel located on Freeman Road in the Maromas
5 section of the city of Middletown to preserve such parcel as open
6 space.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Department of Environmental Protection to make a grant to preserve the parcel located in the Maromas section of Middletown as open space.
