**AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR POLICE TRAINING ON
IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT ISSUES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of ____ dollars be appropriated to the Police Officer
- 2 Standards and Training Council, from the General Fund, for the fiscal
- 3 year ending June 30, 2009, for the purpose of a specialized training
- 4 class focusing on immigration enforcement issues which shall be made
- 5 part of the standard curriculum and will allow local police officers to
- 6 be deputized by towns to enforce immigration law.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding for a police training class that would allow local police officers to be deputized by towns to enforce immigration law.
