AN ACT CONCERNING INVESTMENTS IN CAREER DEVELOPMENT SERVICES AND INCUMBENT WORKER TRAINING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2008*) The sum of one million six
2 hundred thousand dollars is appropriated to the Labor Department,
3 from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, for the
4 development of job opportunities for unemployed and
5 underemployed older youth and adult workers by the One-Stop
6 Centers, pursuant to section 31-3gg of the general statutes, in
7 collaboration with the regional workforce development boards.

8 Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2008*) The sum of three million one
9 hundred thousand dollars is appropriated to the Labor Department,
10 from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, for
11 incumbent worker training in collaboration with the regional
12 workforce development boards.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
