**AN ACT CONCERNING DESIGNATION OF THE LOWER
FARMINGTON RIVER AND SALMON BROOK WITHIN THE NATIONAL
WILD AND SCENIC RIVERS SYSTEM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2008*) (a) It is declared to be the
2 policy of the state of Connecticut that the portion of the Lower
3 Farmington River and Salmon Brook which is the subject of the
4 authorized study by the Lower Farmington River and Salmon Brook
5 Wild and Scenic River Study Committee for purposes of designation as
6 a national wild and scenic rivers system be preserved as provided for
7 in the federal Wild and Scenic Rivers Act, Public Law 90-542, as
8 amended.

9 (b) The Commissioner of Environmental Protection shall cooperate
10 with all relevant federal, state and local agencies to provide for such
11 designation and to implement any management plan developed in
12 accordance with the federal Wild and Scenic Rivers Act. Upon the
13 designation of the Lower Farmington River and Salmon Brook by
14 Congress, the commissioner shall notify the joint standing committee
15 of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the

16 environment regarding any statutory changes necessary to implement
17 the preservation and conservation of the Lower Farmington River and
18 Salmon Brook in accordance with the federal Wild and Scenic Rivers
19 Act. The commissioner shall cause a copy of this section to be
20 delivered to all United States Representatives and Senators
21 representing Connecticut in the Congress of the United States.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
