AN ACT CONCERNING MUNICIPAL REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE TAX CREDIT FOR CERTAIN ELDERLY AND DISABLED HOMEOWNERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (g) of section 12-170aa of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
3 *October 1, 2008, and applicable to assessment years commencing on or after*
4 *October 1, 2008*):

5 (g) On or before July first, annually, each municipality shall submit
6 to the secretary, a claim for the tax reductions approved under this
7 section in relation to the assessment list of October first immediately
8 preceding. On or after December 1, 1987, any municipality which
9 neglects to transmit to the secretary the claim as required by this
10 section shall forfeit two hundred fifty dollars to the state provided the
11 secretary may waive such forfeiture in accordance with procedures
12 and standards established by regulations adopted in accordance with
13 chapter 54. Subject to procedures for review and approval of such data
14 pursuant to section 12-120b, said secretary shall, on or before
15 December fifteenth next following, certify to the Comptroller the
16 amount due each municipality as reimbursement for loss of property

17 tax revenue related to the tax reductions allowed under this section.
 18 The Comptroller shall draw an order on the Treasurer on or before the
 19 fifth business day following December fifteenth and the Treasurer shall
 20 pay the amount due each municipality not later than the thirty-first
 21 day of December. Any claimant aggrieved by the results of the
 22 secretary's review shall have the rights of appeal as set forth in section
 23 12-120b. [The amount of the grant payable to each municipality in any
 24 year in accordance with this section shall be reduced proportionately
 25 in the event that the total of such grants in such year exceeds the
 26 amount appropriated for the purposes of this section with respect to
 27 such year.]

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To reimburse municipalities for one hundred per cent of the property tax credit for elderly homeowners.
