AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR REPLACEMENT OF THE PECK PLACE SCHOOL PLAYGROUND IN THE TOWN OF ORANGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars, the proceeds of which
- 5 shall be used by the Office of Policy and Management for the purpose
- 6 of providing a grant-in-aid to the town of Orange for replacement of
- 7 the Peck Place School playground.

Statement of Purpose:

To fund replacement of the Peck Place School playground in the town of Orange in order to meet current safety standards.
