AN ACT INCREASING TUITION REIMBURSEMENT RATES FOR GENERAL ASSEMBLY EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the appropriation for the General Assembly, for the fiscal year
- 2 ending June 30, 2009, be increased for the purpose of increasing the
- 3 undergraduate and graduate tuition reimbursement rates for courses
- 4 taken by eligible employees of the General Assembly.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide a greater incentive for legislative employees to seek further professional development, maintain their employment with the General Assembly and improve their level of service to the General Assembly and legislative constituents. Higher education costs have increased significantly in recent years, but tuition reimbursement rates for legislative employees have not been adjusted accordingly.
