**AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO EXPAND CONNECTICUT HISTORY EXHIBITS AT THE STATE CAPITOL, LEGISLATIVE OFFICE BUILDING AND OLD STATE HOUSE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars be appropriated
- 2 to the General Assembly, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year
- 3 ending June 30, 2009, for the General Assembly, in consultation with
- 4 the State Commission on Capitol Preservation and Restoration, the
- 5 Museum of Connecticut History and the Connecticut Humanities
- 6 Council, to expand exhibits promoting Connecticut history at the State
- 7 Capitol, Legislative Office Building and Old State House.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide additional funding to promote Connecticut history at the State Capitol, Legislative Office Building and Old State House.
