AN ACT EXPANDING A PROPERTY TAX RELIEF PROGRAM AND PROVIDING STATE REIMBURSEMENT TO TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-170v of the general statutes be amended to (1)
- 2 increase the eligibility income limits to forty thousand dollars for
- 3 individuals and fifty thousand dollars for married couples or civil
- 4 union couples to qualify for this program, and (2) provide that the
- 5 state shall reimburse towns fifty per cent of the lost revenue from this
- 6 program.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the number of elderly homeowners who can qualify for property tax relief and to provide state reimbursement to the towns.
