**AN ACT CONCERNING A STATE INCOME TAX CREDIT FOR
INDIVIDUALS WHO DONATE BLOOD.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-701 of the 2008 supplement to the general statutes be
- 2 amended to provide that individual taxpayers shall receive a twenty-
- 3 five dollar credit against their state income tax liability for each pint of
- 4 blood donated by the individual during a calendar year with the
- 5 maximum tax credit being one hundred dollars per calendar year.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide an incentive for more individuals to donate blood and increase the available blood supply in the state.
