AN ACT REINSTATING THE STATE-WIDE FIREARMS TRAFFICKING TASK FORCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That funding be provided to the Division of State Police, within the
- 2 Department of Public Safety, to reinstate the state-wide firearms
- 3 trafficking task force established pursuant to section 29-38e of the
- 4 general statutes in order to focus law enforcement efforts and
- 5 resources on the eradication of illegal firearms trafficking in this state.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding to reinstate the state-wide firearms trafficking task force and thereby permit the task force to carry out its responsibilities and to focus law enforcement efforts and resources on the eradication of the illegal sale and distribution of firearms in this state.
