AN ACT CONCERNING EXPANSION OF, AND STATE REIMBURSEMENT FOR, A PROPERTY TAX RELIEF PROGRAM FOR THE ELDERLY AND DISABLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-170v of the general statutes be amended to (1)
- 2 expand the number of residents eligible for the elderly and disabled
- 3 property tax relief program by raising the income limits for eligibility
- 4 from \$27,700 for single people and \$33,900 for married couples,
- 5 beyond the automatic cost-of-living increase, and (2) establish state
- 6 reimbursement for such program.

Statement of Purpose:

To reimburse municipalities for the tax loss resulting from a program providing property tax relief for fixed-income elderly homeowners.
