**AN ACT INCREASING FUNDING FOR THE TOWN AID ROAD PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the annual funding for the town aid road program pursuant to
- 2 section 13a-175a of the general statutes be increased from thirty million
- 3 dollars to fifty million dollars.

To assist Connecticut's towns in the construction and maintenance of safe roads by increasing town aid road funding.
