**AN ACT CONCERNING TAX CREDITS FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYERS
PARTICIPATING IN A FLEXTIME PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide a ten per cent tax
- 2 credit for businesses that participate in a flextime program. The
- 3 program would apply to employers that have one hundred or more
- 4 full-time employees who work at a single worksite and begin work
- 5 between six and nine a.m. on two or more weekdays for at least twelve
- 6 continuous months. In addition, the program would apply to state
- 7 agencies and local governments where at least one employer, meeting
- 8 the criteria, is located.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage flextime programs to promote less traffic congestion and pollution, and better accommodate employees' personal schedules.
