**AN ACT CONCERNING BACON CONGREGATE HOUSING.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 3 of special act 00-11 is amended  
2 to read as follows (*Effective from passage*):

3 (a) The Commissioner of Economic and Community Development  
4 shall provide, within available appropriations, subsidies to residents of  
5 Bacon Congregate Housing who are under the age of sixty-two,  
6 provided all eligible congregate project needs under sections 8-119d to  
7 8-119n, inclusive, of the general statutes have been met. Such subsidies  
8 shall be provided on June 30, 2000, and annually thereafter, [until June  
9 30, 2006.]

10 Sec. 2. Section 4 of special act 00-11 is amended to read as follows  
11 (*Effective from passage*):

12 The owner of Bacon Congregate Housing shall report, on or before  
13 June 30, 2001, and annually thereafter, [until June 30, 2006,] to the  
14 Commissioner of Economic and Community Development, on a form  
15 prescribed by the commissioner, concerning the age and status of the

16 population being served by Bacon Congregate Housing.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	SA 00-11, Sec. 3(a)
Sec. 2	<i>from passage</i>	SA 00-11, Sec. 4

**Statement of Purpose:**

To extend the date that the remaining three residents of Bacon Congregate Housing that are under the age of 62 can reside in such housing.
