AN ACT SHIELDING FIRE DEPARTMENTS THAT INSTALL SMOKE AND CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS FROM LIABILITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2008*) No cause of action shall
2 arise against any fire department for installing smoke detectors, carbon
3 monoxide detectors, combination smoke and carbon monoxide
4 detectors or batteries in any such detectors in any building, providing
5 such detectors or batteries are installed in accordance with the
6 manufacturer's instructions and are installed in such department's
7 official capacity. For the purposes of this section, "fire department"
8 includes any municipal fire department, independent fire department,
9 fire district or independent fire company, and any member thereof.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
