**AN ACT CONCERNING A DEVELOPMENTAL OFFICER FOR
VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL SCHOOLS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the appropriation to the Department of Education for personal
- 2 services, from the General Fund, be increased for the fiscal year ending
- 3 June 30, 2009, to allow each vocational-technical school to hire a
- 4 developmental officer or dedicate an existing employee to such a role.
- 5 It is further proposed that each vocational-technical school be required
- 6 to hire such a person or dedicate a person to such a role and that such
- 7 person promote the school throughout the middle schools in the
- 8 region that the vocational-technical school serves.

Statement of Purpose:

To promote the programs offered by vocational-technical schools and create awareness of the real-world training such schools provide students of Connecticut.
