**AN ACT CONCERNING CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE REGISTRATIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 21a-316 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2008*):

3 (a) As used in this chapter, "practitioner" means: (1) A physician,  
4 dentist, veterinarian, podiatrist, optometrist, physician assistant  
5 licensed pursuant to section 20-12b of the 2008 supplement to the  
6 general statutes, advanced practice registered nurse as defined in  
7 subsection (b) of section 20-87a, nurse-midwife, scientific investigator  
8 or other person licensed, registered or otherwise permitted to  
9 distribute, dispense, conduct research with respect to or to administer  
10 a controlled substance in the course of professional practice or research  
11 in this state; (2) a hospital or other institution licensed, registered or  
12 otherwise permitted to distribute, dispense, conduct research with  
13 respect to or to administer a controlled substance in the course of  
14 professional practice or research in this state.

15 (b) As used in this chapter, "doctor in training" means a resident or

16 fellow in a training program within this state.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
