AN ACT CONCERNING CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE REGISTRATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 21a-318 of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2008*):

3 An application for registration pursuant to this chapter shall be
4 made upon a form provided by the Commissioner of Consumer
5 Protection and shall be accompanied by a fee of [ten] twenty dollars for
6 [annual] biennial registration, except that a practitioner who obtains
7 such registration pursuant to the practitioner's employment with a
8 municipality, this state or the federal government shall not be required
9 to pay the fee.

10 Sec. 2. Section 21a-321 of the general statutes is repealed and the
11 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2008*):

12 Registration may be renewed by application to the Commissioner of
13 Consumer Protection. Renewal applications shall be in such form as
14 the commissioner shall prescribe and shall be accompanied by [an
15 annual] a biennial renewal fee of [ten] twenty dollars. A separate fee
16 shall be required for each place of business or professional practice
17 where the practitioner stores, distributes or dispenses controlled
18 substances.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
