AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONTROL OF LYME DISEASE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective from passage) The Commissioner of
- 2 Environmental Protection, in consultation with the Commissioner of
- 3 Public Health, shall develop a comprehensive program to reduce the
- 4 incidence of Lyme disease in the state. The program shall include, but
- 5 not be limited to, maintaining deer populations at manageable levels,
- 6 increasing public awareness of the causes and prevention of Lyme
- 7 disease, and assistance to municipalities in high Lyme disease
- 8 incidence areas.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
