AN ACT CONCERNING PAYMENT OF PERSONAL SERVICE CONTRACTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding any
2 provision of the general statutes, each personal service contract
3 entered into by the state, including, but not limited to, personal service
4 contracts for the provision of health and human services, shall contain
5 the following provisions: (1) A requirement that once any such
6 contract is issued by the state contracting agency, accepted by the
7 contractor and returned to such state contracting agency, such contract
8 shall be approved or rejected by such state contracting agency not later
9 than thirty days after such contract is returned to such agency by the
10 contractor; and (2) a requirement that the state contracting agency pay
11 the contractor any amounts due under such contract, for services
12 rendered, not later than thirty days after such agency receives a
13 written request for such payment from such contractor.
