AN ACT CONCERNING CROSS-ENDORSED CANDIDATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 9-167a of the general statutes is amended by
2 adding subsection (h) as follows (*Effective from passage*):

3 (NEW) (h) For any election in which a candidate was cross-
4 endorsed by two or more political parties, minority parties or
5 otherwise, such cross-endorsed candidate shall be considered a
6 member of the political party from which he or she received the
7 highest total number of votes on such party line for the office sought.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To clarify the party that a cross-endorsed candidate is considered to be in for purposes of minority representation.
