**AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF SALES TAX REVENUE FOR
OPEN SPACE LAND.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that one-quarter of
- 2 one per cent of all moneys collected by the state from the sales tax
- 3 pursuant to sections 12-406 to 12-410, inclusive, of the general statutes
- 4 shall be paid to the Department of Environmental Protection for the
- 5 purchase and preservation of open space land.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that one-quarter of one per cent of the revenue from the sales tax be used for the preservation of open space.
