**AN ACT PROVIDING AN EXEMPTION FROM THE INCOME TAX FOR
A MEMBER OF THE MILITARY WHO IS DEPLOYED IN A COMBAT
ZONE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 229 of the general statutes be amended to exempt from
- 2 the state income tax any income of a member of the military and such
- 3 member's spouse for any year in which such member is deployed in a
- 4 combat zone.

Statement of Purpose:

To exempt from the state income tax any income of a member of the military and such member's spouse for any year in which such member is deployed to a combat zone.
