AN ACT CONCERNING HEALTH BENEFITS FOR STATE MARSHALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (l) of section 5-259 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
3 *1, 2008*):

4 (l) (1) Effective July 1, 1996, any deputies or special deputies
5 appointed pursuant to section 6-37 of the general statutes, revision of
6 1958, revised to 1999, or section 6-43, shall be allowed to participate in
7 the plan or plans procured by the Comptroller pursuant to subsection
8 (a) of this section. Such participation shall be voluntary and the
9 participant shall pay the full cost of the coverage under such plan.

10 (2) Effective December 1, 2000, any state marshal shall be allowed to
11 participate in the plan or plans procured by the Comptroller pursuant
12 to subsection (a) of this section. Such participation shall be voluntary
13 and the participant shall pay prior to July 1, 2008, the full cost of the
14 coverage under such plan. On and after July 1, 2008, the participant
15 shall pay the same amount for such coverage as a state employee in
16 accordance with the provisions of said subsection (a).

17 (3) Effective December 1, 2000, any judicial marshal shall be allowed
18 to participate in the plan or plans procured by the Comptroller
19 pursuant to subsection (a) of this section. Such participation shall be
20 voluntary and the participant shall pay the full cost of the coverage
21 under such plan unless and until the judicial marshals participate in
22 the plan or plans procured by the Comptroller under section 5-259
23 through collective bargaining negotiations pursuant to subsection (f) of
24 section 5-278.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To allow state marshals to receive health benefits under the same terms and conditions and at the same cost as state employees.
