**AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR AN ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY PARK.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 two hundred seven thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall be
- 5 used by the Department of Environmental Protection for the purpose
- 6 of providing a grant-in-aid to the town of Hebron to create an
- 7 environmentally friendly park, with a "green" boiler, solar lights and
- 8 heat, and new composting technology.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide a grant for funds for the creation of a green park in Hebron.
