**AN ACT CONCERNING THE CLASSIFICATION OF JOHN DEMPSEY HOSPITAL AS A HOSPITAL FOR PURPOSES OF THE STATE GRANT IN LIEU OF TAXES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to change the classification of
- 2 the John Dempsey Hospital, for purposes of the state grant in lieu of
- 3 taxes, from a state building to a hospital.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide a more adequate state grant in lieu of taxes to the town of Farmington, where the John Dempsey Hospital is located.
