**AN ACT CONCERNING A DEDUCTION FROM THE PERSONAL
INCOME TAX FOR MEDICAL AND DENTAL EXPENSES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 229 of the general statutes be amended to provide a
- 2 deduction from the personal income tax for medical and dental
- 3 expenses that are in excess of the seven and one-half per cent of federal
- 4 adjusted gross income that may be claimed on an individual's federal
- 5 income tax return.

Statement of Purpose:

To enact a deduction from personal income tax for medical and dental expenses.
