**AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS OF THE STATE TO PLACE A
PLAQUE OR OTHER SUITABLE MARKER ON MOUNT FRISSELL.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of ten thousand dollars be appropriated to the
- 2 Department of Environmental Protection, from the General Fund, for
- 3 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, for the purpose of placing a bronze
- 4 plaque or other suitable marker on the top of Mount Frissell
- 5 recognizing it as the highest point in Connecticut.
